RATIONALE

The field of gastroenterology is witnessing transformative advancements, necessitating a dedicated platform for professionals to engage and share insights. This European congress will focus on groundbreaking developments in many fields of gastroenterology, such as the diagnosis and management of inflammatory bowel disease and irritable bowel syndrome, highlighting innovative therapies that aim to improve patient outcomes significantly, as well as the novelties around coeliac disease and viral hepatitis. The rapid and continuous improvement of interventional endoscopy especially in the field of luminal resectional techniques, is providing more precise and less invasive options for patients. Finally, obesity is a pandemic that necessitates integration of the novel pharmacological approaches with surgical and minimal-invasive endoscopic treatment. By fostering an environment of collaboration and learning, this event aims to advance the understanding and application of cutting-edge technologies and strategies in gastroenterology, ultimately improving patient care and outcomes.
